Workshop #1 "Right Hand Technique Development" with Beverley Fess Fri 9:30 am Grange/Upper

I believe that a well-rounded musician needs to have a solid foundation in order to perform the music to his or her best potential. In this hands-on workshop we will focus on building right hand finger control. Please bring your instruments and a music stand.
