ADULT CATEGORY OUTLINE:

Categories will be scheduled as follows:

- 1. Accordion: Classical Solo, Non-Classical Solo, Evaluation, Duets
- 2. Piano: Classical Solo, Non-Classical Solo, Evaluation, Duets
- 3. Voice: Classical Solo, Non-Classical Solo, Evaluation, Duets
- 4. Guitar: Classical Solo, Non-Classical Solo, Evaluation, Duets
- 5. Drum: Full Set, Snare Solo, Evaluation
- 6. Adult Groups: Minimum of four members, All instruments may be included.

At the completion of all adult categories there will be an Awards Ceremony for all Adult Contestants in the same room where the Adult Competition is held.

NEW CATEGORIES:

*New England Adult Accordion Championship:

- This will be a competitive category and will take place on Saturday.
- Entry fee is \$40.00.
- Contestants will perform two classical pieces, one of which must be an original composition written for the accordion.
- Memorization is optional and a clean copy of music must be supplied.
- Trophies will be awarded at the Awards Banquet on Saturday evening.

*Adult Digital Non-Classical Accordion Solo:

- Contestants will perform one or a medley of selections of their choice.
- Digital sounds and accompaniments may be used.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Adult categories will be for all age 23 & over.
- Adult Contestants do not have to take lessons from an ATAM members' music school.
- Adult contestants will be scored on their individual performance and judged on interpretation, tempo, dynamics, phrasing, technique and musicianship.
 - o Gold Medal: Excellent (95-100)
 - Silver Medal: Very Good (90-94)
 - o Bronze Medal (85-89)
- A scored certificate & trophy will be given to those doing a private evaluation.
- Each contestant or family will be charged a registration fee of \$15.00 which includes one program, and one souvenir gift for each contestant.
- Entry fees for categories are:
- * \$40.00 for Adult Accordion Championship
 - \$20.00 for all solos and evaluation
 - o \$10.00 per member for duets & groups.
- Memorization is optional.
- Time limits must be observed.
- A clean copy of music must be submitted for any NE Adult Accordion Championship, Classical Solos, Snare Solos, Full Set Solos and Duets. Clean copies not required for any Non-Classical Solos. Groups must submit a score.
- A PA system, microphones, digital piano and drum set (if necessary) will be provided. Contestants must use the equipment supplied by the ATAM.
- Contestants may use recorded accompaniment in Non-Classical Guitar, Non-Classical Voice and Full Set Solo.

What is New England Music Festival?

The New England Music Festival is an annual musical competition sponsored by the Accordion Teachers Association of Massachusetts (ATAM), Inc. Each year, 800 contestants from all over New England (more than 3,000 entries). In 2019, adult categories were added. See the <u>adult category information</u> and <u>entry form</u>.

Who can participate?

Participants must be students of <u>ATAM member teachers</u>

*Note: Adult participants are not required to be affiliated with an ATAM member teacher or an ATAM member studio. See the <u>adult category information</u> and <u>entry form</u>.

What are the competition rules?

- Contestant cut-off age is 22 as of April 1, current year. Adult category contestants must be over the age of 22.
- All music must be memorized except snare solos, all duets and groups. If you are using music for a duet, please bring your own stand.
- Time limits apply to music chosen by the students and teachers. See your teacher for guidelines.
- Students must submit a clean copy of music to the judges in categories that apply. See your teacher for details.
- Contact an ATAM school, studio, or teacher for additional information.

What are the costs of participating?

Fees are subject to change each year, so please contact a participating ATAM studio or teacher.

When is the registration cut-off date?

Each school has its own date to allow for timely registration and preparation. Please contact your teacher for cut-off dates.

What are some of the benefits of participating in the event?

The ATAM offers a \$500 and a \$250 scholarship opportunity to graduating high school seniors who are participating in the festival and are going to major in music. See the <u>current year scholarship form</u>.
